2. Presentation and Approval of Investment Priorities

Jackie Spainhower provided a review of the 2007 statewide planning process. She explained that if the state could generate either \$200 million or \$600 million, what types of projects should be funded in the Mo-Kan region. District 1 RPCs elected to go with initiatives instead of specific projects. Spainhower visited with all the commissions to gather their opinions on the presented initiatives, which included Safety, Bridges, Shoulders, Minor Routes, Interchanges and Multi-modal.

Dan Hegeman made the motion to accept the list as presented, seconded by Dan Hausman. Motion carried, 9-0.

3. Presentation and Approval of Top Regional Needs

Shannon Kusilek with MoDOT D1 further explained how the RPCs will take the prioritized initiatives and the needs identified in the region down to Jefferson City in September to promote them statewide.
