Transportation Surveys- Developed with Green Hills and NorthWest RPC's. Jackie did a quick overview of the survey website. Reviewed questions on the survey with answers to date. Web-site survey went on-line in mid November and have had 80 respondents so far. This survey can be maintained for up to one year. We can also ask more questions if needed.

Safe Routes to School Program- Approximately 2.6 million dollars available for infrastructure projects within a two mile radius of schools. This could be used for projects such as sidewalks, traffic calming, speed reduction and many other of this type of project. Applications are due by January 31, 2007. Applications can be submitted online.

2007 Blueprint for Roadway Safety Conference- Attended a three day conference in St. Louis. Presented great ideas for reduction in fatalities on the roadways. Reduce the number below 1,000 by 2008.

Project Identification-Need to identify the needs for each county and score the needs. Jackie reviewed the needs from the previous year and asked if the needs have changed or others need to be added. It was a general consensus for Tom and Jackie to visit the County Commissioners prior to the March meeting to gather needs for this year.

MoDOT Planning Update-SRI has officially been completed. Now starting to focus on bridges. Safe and Sound Program for the bridges. Starting to look very good. Have had four successful applicants qualify for the bidding process. One from Kansas City, one from St. Louis and two from out of state.

85 in 5 program-85% of major routes would be in good condition in those five years. Develop a plan to determine if we could accomplish the 85 in 5 program as a reality.

The next meeting will be held March 14, 2007. This is the second Wednesday in March.
