A meeting of the Mo-Kan Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) was held March 8, 2023, at the Mo-Kan Regional Council office, 224 North 7th Street, St. Joseph, MO. Bruce Lundy called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Trevor Tutt took attendance. There was a quorum present.

Open Public Comment:

Hunter Kelly introduced himself

Old Business:

1. Approval of Minutes from November 9, 2022 – Moved by Johnnie Hoggatt and seconded by Chet Owen. The motion passed unanimously

2.

New Business:

1. Recent Project Awards/Upcoming Bid Openings – Adam Wood reported on recent projects awards and upcoming bid openings. Recent Projects in Buchanan County include I-229
Rehabilitation over 6th and Atchison ½ mile south of US 36 went to Comanche Construction, Inc. in December. Route Y Bridge Replacement was awarded to Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc. in January. In Clinton County Route NN Bridge Replacement and pavement improvements over Castile Creek, .9 miles east of Route K was awarded to Lehman Construction, LLC in December. Also, the conversion of the southbound I-35 Rest Areas was awarded to Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc. in January. Adam Wood mentioned that in January it was decided to push back most pavement projects as bids have raised due to inflation and many only received one bidder so 90% of pavement projects have been pushed to 2024 to allow contractors to catch up on projects. Pavement resurfacing on Business 71 and Route 71 have remained on schedule. Hunter Kelly inquired about the single bidder issue and Adam Wood confirmed it was due to the large mileage of resurfacing projects from the low volume work with extra funding available. Missy Meeks inquired about the funding and Dave Earls discussed the governor's funding and the additional funding from the BIL. Trevor Tutt confirmed that engineers are booked up on all projects, not just road projects. Brad Jarvis inquired about the

area of 71 being addressed. Adam Wood also mentioned the bridge replacement over Route H over I-35 6.5 miles south of Cameron is upcoming as well. Brad Jarvis inquired about the northbound exit ramps off 71 to T Highway and Adam Wood agreed to check on it being a part of the 71 resurfacings. Brad Jarvis also mentioned Route F in Andrew County being a problem which had yet to be brought to Adam Wood's attention. Mike O'Donnell asked if 69 was still on schedule to be completed in the summer of 2023. Adam Wood was going to check on it but knew that the intersection of EE was pushed back to fall.

- **2. Governor's Cost Share Program** Two projects, both in the St. Joseph area, were awarded for the Governor's Cost Share Program. Route AC turn lanes on both sides of Messanie Street at the back entrance to the university and Herzog. The city and county both submitted for Pickett Road/Ag Expo Way rebuilding.
- **3. 2024-2028 STIP Outlook** Inflation rate at 30-40% on pavement and 12% on bridges, so project scoping has dominoed further down the line, so no new projects were added to the STIP this year. STIP targets are assuming a 7% inflation rate increase for 5 years, which they are hoping is high, so if it comes in lower, they can program more projects.
- **4.** TAP/LBIP Funding Dave Earls introduced himself, explaining his position working with city and counties on federally funded projects. Before the new bridge program, the Mo-Kan area had completed their bridge projects, so the list of bridge projects is all new. The City of Lathrop had a TAP project prior to the new program and were awarded a second under the new program to continue the same project, so both are being letted at the same time. The City of Savannah was also awarded a TAP project for E Highway which is just starting. Dave Earls reported that the State of Missouri is behind on allocating federal funding for these projects, so another call will come out in June, whether it is for one or two years is unknown. Dave Earls reported that he is on a team to update the website with easier access to information, so he requested feedback if anyone is having difficulty locating information. There is a statewide LPA conference at the end of the month. Bruce Lundy asked how long LPA Certification lasts and Dave Earls confirmed it was good for two years and that someone from the community must be certified for the projects to move forward. Trevor Tutt confirmed that the website has a list of everyone who is certified, and their renewal date and Dave Earls confirmed that it is updated monthly. Mike O'Donnell requested the list so he could make sure there is someone in the city certified. Dave Earls recommended having two people certified in case anything happens. Trevor Tutt asked about the credits in BRO and Dave Earls confirmed that only one county still has a balance, but everyone in Mo-Kan area should be spent. Dave Earls also discussed updating the soft-match balances. Trevor Tutt discussed the Statewide Planner Partner meeting he attended at which MoDOT explained that the federal money on these projects need to move faster to spend the balance down because it is backing up, so their advice is to get the projects moving. Trevor Tutt inquired about SHPO requirements and Dave Earls explained that the goal is to meet the federal requirements to hire a consultant to conduct archaeological reviews which could delay projects by a few months. Dirt work on either side of the right-of-way or bridges are going to be wider, so require archaeological reviews.
- 5. 2023 Unfunded Needs Prioritization Trevor Tutt reported that there was going to be a delay on the STIP and Unfunded Needs. MoDOT's timeline was suggested as March-May for new need identification with the review and public hearing in June. None of Mo-Kan's projects were Tier 1 last year, so meetings with counties will likely be more about reprioritizing and making better cases for our current projects to help move them up in the rankings. Trevor Tutt iterated the need for projects to be beneficial to the entire northwest region to rank higher. Trevor Tutt introduced Lily

Clajus, Mo-Kan's new GIS specialist, who will be able to get us more data and better mapping. The Regional Transportation Plan will be updated by June. Trevor Tutt reported that the Human Services Coordination Transportation Plan was completed last month, went to public hearing, was updated, and submitted.

6. SS4A – Trevor Tutt reported that Mo-Kan applied for a Safe Streets and Roads for All grant to develop a Safety Plan for the City of Gower and the grant was awarded. Trevor Tutt explained the program and revealed that the next round opens in April so suggested the TAC decide if they would like to pursue a larger planning project collectively as the next round will likely be more competitive.

Other Business:

1. Next TAC Meeting – The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for May 10, 2022.

Meeting adjourned at 9:30 am.
